

#### **Policies**

Policies likely saturate your company

Everyone is aware of company policies

They're printed on posters and discussed everywhere



#### **Processes**

Processes are utilized across multiple roles and departments

Everyone in the organization participates in at least 1 action required in a process

Unless automated, communication of process steps rely on word of mouth

They are the connective tissue between Policies and Procedures



#### **Procedures**


Procedures are limited to one person or role

They're available in digital or physical form, probably on the user's desk








Once they've taken their action, the workflow proceeds to the next step.



**Automated** process workflows are the key












### **ENTER: The Magic of Automation**



- The system automatically sends a notification to each assigned owner when their actions are needed.
- Once they've taken their action and mark it complete, the system notification proceeds to the next assigned owner removing the chance for human error.
